Baby Was Crying for Mother
Who Was Cold in Death.

Mrs. Jamison had some sewing to do and after the baby had fallen asleep and was tucked under the warm covers in his little crib beside the bed, she went down stairs, leaving her husband also asleep. Several hours later he was awakened by the cries of the little one and called to his wife to quiet the child.

Receiving no reply, Jamison discovered she was not in the bed and as it was then half past one o'clock he concluded that something was wrong and hurried down stairs to the kitchen.

There on the floor lay his young wife and one touch of her body disclosed to him that his help mate had departed this world. The sewing which she had been working on lay beside her.

The distracted husband rushed into the street and meeting Policeman Toy informed him of what had happened. Coroner Bushey was notified and after viewing the body he gave a certificate of death from heart failure.

In the meantime the child was still crying for its mother and kind-hearted neighbors volunteered to assist the grief-stricken husband. Mrs. Jamison was only 22 years of age.
