MONTH IN PRISON TO THINK IT OVER

Some time ago Florence Keating, of 811 Daughin street, got a bill of separation from her husband John. Yesterday he visited her home while drunk and left its furnishings a wreck. Mrs. Keating ran out of the house on his approach and had Policeman Appley lock him up.

Mrs. Keating told Recorder Stackhouse this morning that he broke up her furniture, smashed her crockery, tore up carpets and bed linen and smashed the gas range. He left the house a complete wreck, said Mrs. Keating.

Keating denied his wife's charges, and said he had offered her \$12 a week.

Mrs. Keating laughed at this and said that she had told her husband she would take him back if he would keep sober and do the right thing by her.

Keating also denied smashing his wife's furniture and claimed that she insisted on going to a house on Pine street that he did not want her to visit.

Mrs. Keating stated that she stopped at the house of friends on Pine street while she was ill.

Policeman Appley said that when he got to Mrs. Keating's house the floors were covered with broken dishes, the gas range was torn out and Keating was in the act of tearing up a bed-sheet.

The Recorder sent Keating to jail for a month.
