

## BREAKING OF BED LEADS TO COURT

Mrs. Estella Wright and Mrs. Florence Keating are sisters. Mrs. Keating and her four small children lived with Mrs. Wright, at 815 Dauphin street, for a time, occupying one room, all sleeping in one bed.

Several days ago the bed broke and Mrs. Wright took her sister to task about it. A violent quarrel arose, during which Mrs. Keating was abused so terribly that she immediately packed up her belongings and moved to 823 Dauphin street.

When she went out to the store to make some purchases yesterday Mrs. Wright hailed her and abused her again. Mrs. Keating made a complaint of disorderly conduct against her sister before Alderman Weaver, and the hearing took place last night.

Both sides were represented by lawyers. Mrs. Keating and her two witnesses told of the occurrence in such a straightforward manner that the lawyer for the defense could not shake them in the least by cross examination.

Mrs. Wright had twenty-five witnesses in her behalf, but by the time their evidence was sifted it was found to be hearsay. Alderman Weaver adjudged Mrs. Wright guilty and imposed a fine of \$3.30.
