Boarder at Policeman Hill's
Home May Know Something
of Missing Cash.

FOUND INTOXICATED ON THE SIDEWALK

James, better known as "Jeff," Keating, is under arrest on a charge of intoxication, back of which is a suspicion that he robbed the purse of Mrs. George Hill, wife of Policeman Hill.

Keating was too drunk to give an intelligent answer and then Policeman Hill investigated his pockets, finding a dollar and six cents and a Mexican half-dollar some foxy bartender had given him in change.

While Policeman Hill was searching Keating for the stolen money, Peter McGrath, of 237 Kaighn avenue, happened along and protested. He told Hill he had no right to search a man without a warrant. Hill told him to go on and mind his own business. McGrath flatly refused and informed the big policeman that he was as good a man as he was. Hill then put McGrath under arrest for interfering with an officer. The man made a pass at Hill, but missed him and was soon suppressed.

Keating was still too drunk to be given a hearing in Police Court this forenoon. Acting Recorder Knight held disposition of McGrath's case under advisement.
